For more than 40 years, the prosthetic and orthotic clinic at Freeport Health Centre has provided high quality service to the Waterloo Region and surrounding areas. The prosthetic and orthotic clinic is an outpatient clinic that provides a comprehensive interdisciplinary team assessment for the prescription of a prosthesis (artificial limb) or an orthosis (orthopedic brace) in order to improve mobility, independence and quality of life. Our clinic also provides long-term follow up and maintenance services for clients who are currently using assistive devices.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- ❑ Individuals who have lost a limb due to an accident or illness and who require an artificial limb
- ❑ Individuals with neurological and musculoskeletal disorders whose mobility and independence can be improved by the use of a brace.
